## PORTUGUESE MINOR

#### PREREQUISITES:

To enter the Portuguese minor, students must have an overall grade-point average of 2.0 and must complete or show proficiency equivalent to two years of college-level Portuguese. ### UPPER DIVISION REQUIREMENTS:

• A total of five (5) upper division electives selected from 100A through 199, 3 of which must be taught in Portuguese or have a Portuguese adjunct course (187FL).
