PREREQUISITES:

To declare the Mexican Studies minor, students must have an overall grade-point average of 2.0, have completed or received credit equivalent to Spanish 5 (or higher) and must meet with the department counselor in Rolfe 5314. All minor courses must be taken for a letter grade. Successful completion of the minor is indicated on the transcript and diploma.

The Mexican Studies minor is comprised of 7 courses total.
