

SPANISH LINGUISTICS MINOR

PREREQUISITES: To declare the Spanish Linguistics Minor, students must have an overall GPA of 2.0, must complete all lower division requirements, and must meet with the Department Counselor. Students must have completed or received credit equivalent to Spanish 5. All courses must be taken for a letter grade and students **must obtain at least a “C”** in *all courses towards the minor*. Successful completion of the minor is indicated on the transcript and diploma.
