

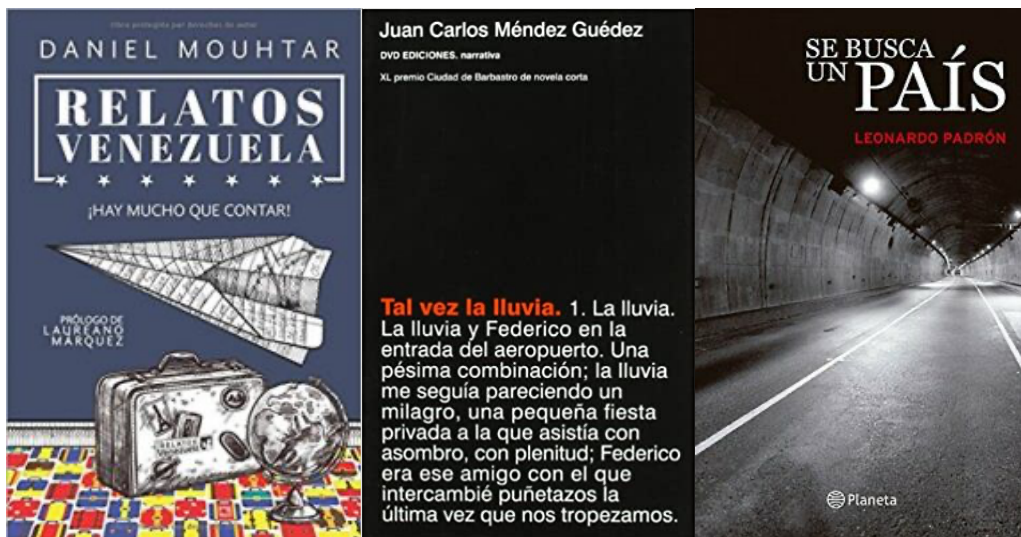
“CAPITAL HUMANO EN FUGA, EL DERRUMBE DE UNA NACIÓN”

In this talk, Sonia Barrios Tinoco discusses the ongoing Venezuelan social, political and economic crisis as the cause of migration in the works *Tal vez la lluvia* (2009) by Juan Carlos Méndez Guédez, *Se busca un país* (2015) by Leonardo Padrón and *Relatos Venezuela* (2017).

Sonia Barrios Tinoco is an Associate Professor in Spanish and Chair of the Modern Languages and Cultures Department at Seattle University. She studied Literature at the Universidad Católica Andrés Bello in Venezuela, and then earned a Spanish Literature Master’s Degree at Washington State University and a Hispanic Languages and Literatures Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley.
